GENERAL INFORMATION

The **European Values Summit** is an annual, closed-door, international security event focused on countering Russian and Chinese malign influence activities. It provides an established and recognized platform for governments, selected trusted NGO partners, experts, politicians, and senior officials from NATO countries and their allies.

The main goal of the Summit is to discuss effective practices and policies for countering Russian and Chinese malign influence. There will be an opportunity to meet in person with more than 200 governmental experts, stakeholders, and relevant civil society figures from 20+ allied countries. The European Values Summit will duly provide a platform for discussion and policy development related not only to strategic communication.

This year's Summit is to be held under the auspices of the President of the Czech Republic.

For your visit, we created the following **Conference Package** in order to help you prepare for the conference in advance. This document provides practical information to participants of the Summit, including general information on the logistical and organizational aspects.

ARRIVING TO THE VENUE

There are more ways how to get to the [Kaiserstein Palace](#), the place where the summit takes places. The Palace is located at a square called Malostranské náměstí, where following public transportation stops are located:



You can also use a subway service. However, the closest station is **Malostranská**, which is located 6-8 minutes by walk and a bit up to a hill. Nevertheless, you can also transfer from to **Malostranská metro station** to **Malostranské náměstí**. For getting to **Malostranská**, use **line A**, the green metro line:



To transfer to **Malostranské náměstí**, use **trams number 12, 15, 20 and 22**:



Purchasing Tickets – Public Integrate Transport (PIT)

Public transport tickets must be purchased in advance before you board boards the bus, tram, or metro. Tickets are sold in the **Visitor Centre**, at the Prague Public Transit company counters in Arrival Halls, or from **ticket vending machines** located throughout both terminals and directly at bus stops. Most ticket machines accept contactless credit card payments. Tickets can also be purchased via **SMS** or the **Lítačka mobile app**, which can be also used to search for the ideal public transport connection. The application is available for [Android](#) and [iOS](#).

ARRIVING FROM THE AIRPORT

When you will be arriving from the **Václav Havel Airport Prague**, you can use the public transportation. More information on transport from the airport can be found at the Václav Havel Airport Prague [website](#).

To travel to city center, you can use either buses of PIT (day line **100, 119, 191**, night line **907, 910**), or a special bus Airport Express (**AE**):

On the map you can see various means of getting from the airport. Green arrow will get you to metro line A, yellow to metro line B, and red is for metro line C. In case you will be traveling directly from the airport to the venue, consider using **green metro line A** and traveling to the station **Malostranská**, as mentioned in the section [ARRIVING TO THE VENUE](#).

Airport Express directly connects to **Prague Main Railway Station** (Praha hlavní nádraží), however you need to have a special ticket purchased for this travel, as mentioned below.

Purchasing Tickets for the Airport Express (AE)

It is not possible to use regular public transport tickets for rides aboard the Airport Express. When travelling from the airport, the Airport Express bus tickets may be purchased in the **Visitor Centre at Arrival Hall** or **directly from the driver**.

SUMMIT VENUE

The summit will be held at **Kaiserstein Palace**, [Malostranské nám. 23/37, Prague 1](#). Suggested arrival is between 8:00 and 8:30.

Kaiserstein Palace is a place of historical importance, initially built for Franz Helfried, Baron of Kaiserstein, whose coat-of-arms can be still found above one of the windows. Originally a renaissance building dating from 1630, it was substantially restyled in 1714 by the Italian architect Giovanni Battista Aliprandi, who is also famous for Hartig, Sternberg, Lobkowitz, and Hrzan palace. The construction was overseen by Krystof Dientzenhofer. The statues of the four elements that appear on the roof of the building are by the Italian sculptor Ottavio Mosto.

As of 1964 it is protected as a historical landmark by UNESCO.

A number of celebrated names are associated with the house. From 1835 to 1845 it was the residence of Joachim Barrande, the French-born geologist who gave his name to the district of Barrandov. From 1908 to 1914, the world-famous operatic soprano Ema Destinová (Emmy Destinn) lived here.

Kaiserstein Palace has a variety of halls and function rooms available to meet all social event requirements in a refined style, therefore it makes perfect venue for the event.

- Currency: Czech Crown
- 1 EUR = 25 CZK 1 USD = 20.5 CZK
- Card payments widely accepted, contactless or Apple Pay/Google Pay available
- Follow basic safety rules for money exchange
- **Expiry of CZK Banknotes:** The validity of older types of banknotes **with a thin silver strip** in the nominal value of CZK 100, 200, 500, 1,000 and 2,000 **ends on 30 June 2022**. The banknotes are no longer accepted. Invalid banknotes can be exchanged at the cash desks in banks and in the Czech National Bank. More information is available [here](#).

- 50 / 90 / 130 Km/h speed limits

- Customary tips up to 10 %

- No roaming fees among EU member states

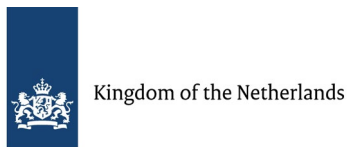

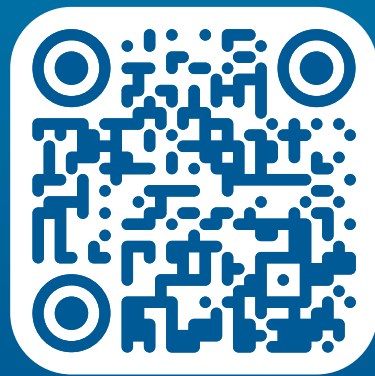
